Earl E. Noble, 85, a lifelong Rush County-Arlington area resident, passed away November 13, 2017 in Rushville. Earl was born June 29, 1932 in Rush County to Merrill Noble & Gladys (Colestock) Doughty. Earl was a 1950 graduate of Arlington High School. He was a US Army veteran and served in the Korean War. Earl married Frances Watson on May 9, 1953 and she survives.
