Beverly Kay Jackson, 81, of Spiceland and formerly of Knightstown passed away Saturday, September 1, 2018 in Indianapolis, IN. Kay was born in Shelbyville on March 24, 1937 to the late Glen and Lora (Meloy) Mohler. She was a 1955 graduate of Shelbyville High School. Kay grew up with music and played instruments in the Shelby County Farm Bureau and high school band. Kay married Donald R. Jackson on July 22, 1956 and he survives. She lived in Knightstown for many years, her and Don reopened and operated the Knightstown Locker for many years and she was a devoted homemaker and housewife. Kay was a faithful Christian and was baptized at Mt. Pisgah Church and was a current member of Center Christian Church. She sang in the choir and was a member of The Loyal Workers since 1964 and enjoyed giving back to the church. Kay went on the 2000 Holy Land Tour which was the highlight of her Christian life.

Kay is survived by her husband, Don, a son, Jeff Jackson and wife Risa of Indianapolis, sister, Marilyn Denny also of Indianapolis, 4 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren.

In addition to her parents Kay was preceded in death by a daughter, Janet Kay Jackson and her brother Steven Mohler.
