Billie F. Hackler, 83, a longtime Rushville resident passed away Saturday, January 24, 2015 at her home in Rushville. Billie was born on December 2, 1931 in Lexington, KY to the late David Winkle and Dora (Rhorer) Simms. Billie married Harvey Hackler on August 25, 1951 and he preceded her in death on June 29, 1987. She worked at Schnadig and was a wife, mother and homemaker as well. Billie was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Rushville.

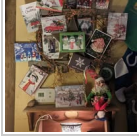

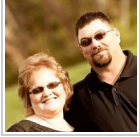

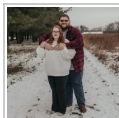
