Brian Lee (B.L.) Cain, 68, currently of Rushville, passed away February 27, 2026 at home in Rushville. He was born August 28, 1957 in Beech Grove to the late Oliver P. Cain II and Phyllis (Stevens) Cain. Brian was a 1975 graduate of Rushville High School and a 1980 graduate of Jefferson Davis State Junior College. He also was a graduate of Seattle Filmworks School of Photography. Brian married Patricia Lee (Moore) Dickson Cain on April 22, 1995 and she survives.

Brian served his country in the United States Navy. He was an award winning photojournalist, having worked at the Rushville Republican, the Winchester News-Gazette, The Hartford City News Times and Union City Times. Brian later worked for Valeo Engine Cooling where he served as a Fin Mill Technician, Team Leader and Line Supervisor.

Brian was a life member of Bass Angler Sportsman Society (BASS) and North American Fishing Club. He had been an avid collector of "Blues" music since the 1970s. Brian was a founding member of the Heart of Rushville.

In addition to his wife, Patty, he is survived by his four daughters, Kimbriana (Robert) Workman of Rushville, Danielle (companion, Geoff Bowman) Cain of Rushville, Alicia Hill of Rushville and Roxanna Conover of Shelbyville; two sons, Brian L. Cain II of Rushville and David (Terri) Dickson of Rushville; sisters, Benita Cain of Creede, CO and Nancy Monte of Vista, CO; brother Christopher Cain of South Fork, CO; 10 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren. He will also be missed by several nieces and nephews.

Brian was preceded in death by his parents, 6 brothers and 2 sisters. Services will be held on Thursday, March 5, 2026 at 1 PM in Moster Mortuary. 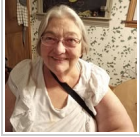
