“ *I'll never forget one time when Kelly and I and another friend from work were rabbit hunting. It was very cold and when a rabbit ran across the frozen surface of a pond my beagle ran after it and broke through the ice several yards out from the bank. He had went under several times and couldn't get back onto the ice and was near drowning to death. I frantically yelled out that I couldn't swim and Kelly didn't destitute to wade into the icy water and rescue him. He would have done the same for anyone or anything else. The last time I saw him we stood and chatted for a long time in a store. He was a good friend and I'll see him again one day. My most heartfelt condolences go out to Wanda and the rest of the family.*
