



## Byron E. Oldham

July 27, 1923 - December 7, 2015

Byron E. Oldham, 92, a life long Rushville resident, passed away December 7, 2015 in Rushville. He was born July 27, 1923 in Rush County to Ralph & Blanche (Lamberson) Oldham. Byron was a 1941 graduate of Rushville High School. He served in the US Army during WW2 from 1942-1945. He married Ruth E. Kile on August 26, 1945 and she preceded him in death on December 3, 2013.

Byron was a rural mail carrier in Rush County for 25 years, retiring in 1977. He worked nearly 15 years at Schnadig Corporation after retiring from the post office. Byron was also a greeter at the Rushville WalMart for many years. He was a 50+ year member of the Rushville Masonic Lodge #62 F&AM, also the York Scottish Rite and the Murat Shrine. For many years Byron was a member & office holder in the Indiana Rural Letter Carriers Association. He is survived by his daughter, Janet Poe of Rushville and his son, Max Oldham & wife Mary of Indianapolis, a brother, Maurice Oldham of Indianapolis, granddaughters, Amanda Poe & Maggie Oldham along with several nieces & nephews. Byron was preceded in death by his parents, wife and a brother, Kenneth Oldham.

Services will be held at 1 PM Friday, December 11, 2015 at St. Paul's United Methodist Church @426 N. Morgan St. in Rushville. Friends are welcome to visit at the church from 10:30 AM until time of service on Friday. Pastor Jan Dimick will preside and entombment will be in the East Hill Shrine Mausoleum.
