



Calvin T. Beaver

December 24, 1907 - October 10, 2011

Calvin Theodore Beaver, 103, a lifelong Rush County resident, passed away at 1:10 AM Monday, October 10 at his daughter's home in Glenwood.

Calvin was born December 24, 1907 in Rush Co., IN to John Chester and Blanche Emma (Murphy) Beaver. He was a 1926 graduate of Connersville High School and obtained his BS in Botany in 1933 from Wabash College where he was a member of the Lamda Chi Alpha fraternity. Calvin was married to Naomi Lucille Boone on July 9, 1933 until her death on August 7, 1964. He then married Eva Morris McElfresh on December 10, 1968 and she passed away in January of 1999. He farmed his entire life in Rush & Fayette counties. Calvin was a longtime member of the Glenwood United Methodist church, a 20 year member of the Glenwood Volunteer Fire Department, one of the founders of the Rush County Tractor Pulls, on the Fayette & Rush County Fair Board, served as Fairview Twp trustee, member of the Fayette Central School board, served one term on the Fayette County Council, member of the Orange Masonic Lodge F&AM, very active at the Rush County Senior Citizen's Center and was an avid woodworker.

He leaves behind his daughter, Betty & husband Paul McDivitt of Glenwood, step-son, Jim & wife Donna McElfresh of Bentonville, step-daughter, Oliverhea & husband Bob Risch of Cambridge City, sister-in-law, Jane Beaver of Glenwood, 3 grandchildren, Beverly & Scott Spurlin of Lake Santee, Paula & Doug Maupin of Glenwood & Christopher McDivitt of Indianapolis, 6 step-grandchildren, 6 great grandchildren, 3 great-great grandchildren and several

nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents and wives, Calvin was preceded in death by brothers, Paul Chester & John Edward and sisters, Lucile, Belva and Emma and 1 step grandchild.
