Charles G. "B.J." Justice, 94 of Rushville, passed away on October 21, 2022 at his home in Rush County. He was born on April 9, 1928 in Henry County to the late Maurice and Lola Lavina (Bennett) Justice. Charles was a 1946 Kennard High School graduate.

He married Mary Johnson on July 23, 1950 and she survives. Charles worked at J&M Machine Shop for several years and drove a school bus for Rush County. He served his country in the United States Army from 1951-1953, during the Korean conflict. Charles was a devoted Pastor in the Church of God from 1962-2007.

In addition to his wife, Mary, he is survived by his children, Charles Allen (Kathy) of Hanover, Lynda (Daryl) Raab of Manilla, Lori (Rick) Johnson of Bluffton, Bryan (Rhonda) Justice of Manilla and Mike (Tammy) Justice of Rushville. He will also be missed by 18 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren.

Charles is preceded in death by his parents, brother, Jack, infant daughter, Charlene Justice, and sister, Helen Justice and grandson, Douglas Raab.
