Clarabelle Clark, 86, a Rushville resident many years, passed away at 2 PM Sunday, August 28, 2011 at the home of her daughter in Corinth, Mississippi where she had been living since 2007.

Clarabelle Christopher was born February 21, 1925 in Rushville, IN to William Lewis and Grace (Wilber) Christopher, both deceased. Clarabelle married Richard Clark on July 10, 1948 and he preceded her in death on July 29, 2007.

She lived in Rushville until 1968, Phoenix from 1968-1986 and Memphis, TN from 1986-2007.
