Clarence W. Green, 86, of Rush County formerly of Battle Creek, MI passed away Thursday, November 26, 2015 at his home in Carthage. Clarence was born on October 15, 1929 in Marshall, MI to the late Charles E. and Mabel R. (Palmer) Green.

Clarence married Frances June Green, his wife of 50 wonderful years and mother of their children in 1955 and she preceded him in death in 2005. He later married Connie Bitner on March 22, 2009 and she survives. Clarence enlisted in the US Navy in 1947 and served 24 years retiring in 1971. He served in Vietnam, also on the USS Arneb AK 56 in Greenland, the USS Grackle AM 513 minesweeper and Fleet Tanker USS Pawcatuck AO 108 during the Cuban Missile Crisis as well as many other Assignments. He was a member of the Morristown American legion #102. Clarence retired from Hi-Lex in Battle, Creek MI.
