January 14, 1915 - March 22, 2015

Clifford Sherwood, 100, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away at his home in Rush County on Sunday March 22, 2015. Clifford was born in Rush County on January 14, 1915 to the late Henry D. and Hazel (McMichel) Sherwood. He married Crystal Lucille Morgan on January 4, 1941 and she preceded him in death on September 16, 1994. In July of 1995 he married Wanda.

Clifford Sherwood served in the US Army during WWII. He was a Rush County farmer and drove a school bus for 22 years and worked at Harcourt Outlines. Clifford was a member of Milroy United Methodist Church, the Milroy F&AM Masonic Lodge and the Scottish Rite. He also worked with the Anderson Township Volunteer Fire Dept. Clifford was a past member of the Milroy Community Club, the Rush County Muskrats and the Milroy Coyote Club and Rushville Elks Lodge #1307.
