Connie Woodin Artmeier, 81 of Rushville, went home to be with the Lord on September 20, 2020. She was born on July 25, 1939 in Kankakee, IL . Connie was the daughter of J.J. “Jeff” Woodin and Sophia Korzeniewski Woodin. She attended Hamburg Catholic Elementary School and Clarksburg High School. Connie was crowned Miss Decatur County in 1957. She was very active in 4-H and working on her parent’s dairy farm. She married David Artmeier on June 28, 1959 at the Clarksburg Christian Church and preceded her in death on January 8, 2020 after 60 years of marriage.

Connie was baptized sixty-five years ago at Mahoning Valley Christian Service Camp in the creek. She was a founding member of the Rushville Church of Christ when the congregation met in a member’s house. Connie began her work career as a secretary at the International Furniture Company; as her children entered Junior High School, she became a sales clerk at the Rushville Pharmacy.
