Darrel W. Wooldridge, 59, of Rushville passed away Wednesday, March 14, 2018 in Indianapolis. Darrel was born in Rushville on October 3, 1958 to the late Charles "Chet" and Mary Ellen (Hyatt) Wooldridge.

Darrel was a 1976 graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School. He received 2 Bachelor's Degrees from ITT in Indianapolis in Electronics and Robotics. 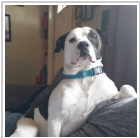
