Delza Milon Huffman, 99, a long time Rush County resident, passed away December 30, 2016 in Rushville. He was born July 16, 1917 in Fayette County to John L. & Wanda F. (Fielding) Huffman.

Delza moved with his family to a farm in Rush County in 1932. He was a farmer all his life. He served in the US Army in Europe during WW2. Delza was a member & Past Master of Phoenix Lodge #62 of Free and Accepted Masons and was also a member of Chapter, Council & Commandery where he was Past Commander. He was also a member of Scottish Rite in Indianapolis and the Trinity United Presbyterian Church where he served as Elder.
