Dick Reed, 91, of Rushville, passed away October 5, 2013 in Rushville. He was born in Franklin County to Edward & Jessica (Williamson) Reed. Dick was a 1940 graduate of Laurel High School & a WW 2 US Navy veteran, serving from 1942-1945. He married Jane Boroski on July 23, 1945 and she preceded him in death on February 12, 1975. He married Judy Finney on April 10, 1976 and she survives.

Dick retired after 40 years as an electrician. He was a member of the Main Street Christian Church, the Rushville Lions Club where he had served as Secretary for 20 years and the Rushville BPOE #1307.
