Doris Jean Wilson, 95, a life long New Salem area resident, passed away November 21, 2013 in Rushville. Doris Jean was born May 21, 1918 in Rush County, IN. She was the third of six children of Chester & Lila Mae (Heath) Ridout. She was a 1937 graduate of Rushville High School. Doris Jean married Norman Ruff Wilson on August 27, 1938 and he preceded her in death on June 20, 2003.

Doris Jean was active many years with the Noble Twp. 4-H Club. In 1986 she received a county 4-H achievement honor. She was an officer of the Eta Chapter of Kappa Kappa Sigma Sorority in which she was active for over 50 years. She attended the Little Flatrock Christian Church and was active in the Christian Women's Fellowship Group where she enjoyed adding a puzzle or humorous objects to her many teachings. Doris Jean worked at the Rushville Woolworth's store in the 1960's.
