January 28, 1932 - October 26, 2014

Dorothy J. Stout, 82, a long time Arlington resident, passed away October 26, 2014 in New Castle, IN. She was born January 28, 1932 in Henry County to Clay & Beulah (Patterson) McSherley. Dorothy was a 1950 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School & a 1954 graduate of Ball State University. She married Robert K. Stout on May 20, 1961 and he preceded her in death on December 16, 2007.

Dorothy was a teacher in Carthage for a few years and then became Dean of Girls at Arsenal Tech High School where she remained for many years. She & her husband were one of the oldest established breeders of miniature horses in the United States. They were well known in the llama and alpaca business and showed these animals throughout the United States. She was a founding member of the American Miniature Horse Association and a member of the International Llama Association. She loved all her animals.

She was survived by good friend and neighbor, Garth Lee of Carthage and cousins, Keith & wife Lillian McSherley and David & wife Marsha Gratner all of Sulphur Springs, IN. In addition to her parents & husband, Dorothy was preceded in death by her brother, Wayne McSherley.
