Eric Lynn Magee "Zeke" was born April 28, 1969 in Greenfield, Indiana to the late Richard Magee and Wonda Riley Magee (Angela Walker). Eric was raised in Carthage, IN in his early life by his Mamaw, the late Flora Magee. He attended Mays, Knightstown, and Carthage Elementary and then Knightstown High School. He then moved to Peru, IN and was cared for until his graduation from Peru High School by his late Aunt Lou Magee (Sue Layman).

Eric was also fortunate to have the loving care of Kay (Dave) Denney. Eric used to joke that his life story could keep an entire season of Jerry Springer going. While living in Peru, Eric became the father to a son, Nicholas Magee (Mary Rose) and a daughter, Morgan (Phil) Wimmer. He adored and loved them more than they will ever know.
