Faye Ellen Lee, 88 a longtime Rush County resident passed away on July 5, 2015 in Rushville. Faye was born on January 25, 1927 in Franklin County, IN to the late Fred J. and Edgardean (McMath) Mohler. Faye was a 1944 graduate of New Salem High School. She married Richard W. Miller on June 4, 1945 and he preceded her in death on September 18, 1956. She married George Lee on September 2, 1967 and he survives. Faye lived her early life in Franklin Co. then in Rush Co. from 1945 to 1955 and in Shelby Co. from 1955 to 1985 when she moved back to Rush Co.

Faye attended IUPUI graduating in 1970 with a BS and Masters in Education. She taught 4th grade for 20 years at Arlington Elementary retiring in 1990. Faye also worked in the kitchen at Flatrock River lodge and part time at McDonalds. She was a member of Fountaintown Christian Church, the OES and Retired Teachers Association.

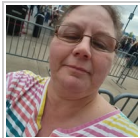

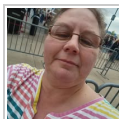
