Floyd Robert Robbins, 73, of Rushville, passed away suddenly at his home on June 10, 2017. He was born on June 6, 1944 in Rushville to the late Robert Nelson and Della Garnet (Hitchel) Robbins. Floyd was a 1962 graduate of Rushville High School. He served in the US Army from 1962-1966. Floyd married Diana Graves on August 19, 1966 and she survives.

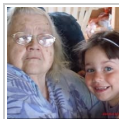
