Frederick W. "Fred" Marshall, 68 of Rushville passed away Friday January 17, 2020 in Indianapolis, IN. Fred was born on June 27, 1951 to the late Chez and Hazel (Bennett) Marshall Jr.

Fred was a 1969 graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School and a 1973 graduate of Hanover College with a Bachelors Degree in Arts. Fred worked as an Accountant for various businesses but his true passion was for acting. He was a professional actor and performed at the Kennedy Center for Performing Arts in 1973 and was an equity actor at Edyvean in Indianapolis. Fred was a member of Main Street Christian Church.
