George D. Maple, 92, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away Monday, July 6, 2015 in Rushville. George was born in Rushville, IN on January 28, 1923 to the late Orville and Nellie (Brown) Maple.

George Married Freda Mosburg on September 1, 1946 and she preceded him in death on November 30, 1993. He served in the US Army 1st Cav. during WWII. George worked at Farthings and Irvin Miller store, the Rushville Fire Department for 7 years and as the meat dept. manager at Marsh retiring after 35 years. He was a member of Main Street Christian Church, American Legion Post #150, the National Rifle Assoc. and the Rush County Honor Guard.

George is survived by 2 sons, George "Tom" Thomas Maple and companion Sandy Fuller of Rushville, Greg Maple and wife Chelly of Morristown, daughter, Linda and husband Whitmer Patterson of Santa Rosa, CA, 8 grandchildren and 14 great-great grandchildren.
