



Glendon "Glenny" McQueen

September 13, 1932 - November 22, 2015

Glendon "Glenny" McQueen, 83, a Milroy area resident since 1984, passed away in Greensburg on November 22, 2015. He was born September 13, 1932 in Franklin County to Goble & Ethel (Sandlin) McQueen. Glenny was a 1950 graduate of Clarksburg High School. He served in the US Army during the Vietnam War. He married Rosalyn Kinnett on July 14, 1954 and she survives.

Glenny farmed his Franklin & Rush County farm his entire life and also was a bus driver in Franklin County for 42 years, retiring in 2007. He was a 50 year member of the Metamora Bible Baptist Church where he served as elder.

Glenny was a long time member of the Laurel Masonic Lodge F&AM, Scottish Rite & Murat Shrine.

In addition to his wife, Rosalyn, of Milroy, he is survived by a son, David (Rhonda) McQueen of Laurel, daughters, Rebecca (Chuck) Lucas of Laurel and Peggy McQueen of Milroy, grandchildren, Trenton McQueen, Cassandra (Karl) Hancock, Amber (Matt) McCallister, Jared (MaLeea) Dowd, Jaynelle (John) Adams, Cassandra (James) McDaniel & Chuck Lucas and 12 great grandchildren. Glenny was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Clarkie & sisters, Viola, Cletus & Gladys.
