Harry Edward Brindley, 85, of Milroy went to be with our Heavenly Father Tuesday, June 4, 2024 at Ashford Place Shelbyville, Indiana. Born July 24, 1938, he was the son of the late Fred and Alta Brindley. He grew up in Switzerland County with his two older sisters until moving to Rush County with his parents at age 11 or 12 where they purchased a farm. He graduated from Mays High School and married Carol Kay McDaniel December 14, 1963. They had a wonderful 48 years of marriage until Carol's passing in 2011.

After graduating high school, Harry served in the Air Force 4 years as a mechanic, a greyhound bus driver and a mail carrier for the Rushville Post Office where he retired after 30 years. He was a member of the Moscow Christian Church and loved driving to and residing in Florida and spending time with his family. Harry married Wilma Mock in 2012 who survives.
