Howard W. Fletcher, 98, a lifelong Clarksburg community resident passed away Saturday April 18, 2015 at his home. Howard was born on November 3, 1916 in Decatur Co., IN to the late Carl D. and Grace (Humphrey) Fletcher. Howard Married Ruth A. Robbins on June 19, 1938 and she preceded him in death on September 10, 2003.
