Jack E. Manning, 75, a 50 year resident of Irvington, passed away at his home in Irvington on December 5, 2014. He was born November 11, 1939 in Rushville to William E. Manning & Thelma M. (Holding) Hardwick. Jack was an E3 in the US Navy, serving from 1957-1960. He served on the USS Bang and was a member of the USS V1 Submarine Group. He was a 1957 graduate of Rushville High School. Jack married Betty Riggs on July 2, 1961. Jack worked for and was a member of the Local #440 Union in Indianapolis as a Mechanical Contractor/refrigeration pipefitter for 40 years. He and his wife also owned & operated T & M Associates for 5 years. Jack was the #11 Contractor in the State of Indiana at one time. Jack was a member of the Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Irvington, the SAS & the NRA. He was an avid outdoorsman, marksman & expert fly fisherman.

He is survived by his wife, Betty, of Irvington, his mother, Thelma Hardwick of Indianapolis, a son, Craig & wife Sharon Manning of Farmington Hills, MI, daughters, Kimberly & husband Dan Petry and Laurel & husband Dan Pritt all of Indianapolis, grandchildren, Michael Petry, Sarah Pritt and Amelia & Lorelai Manning. Jack was preceded in death by his father, a brother, Fred Manning and step father, Vernon Hardwick.
