James Robert Ephlin, 69, a long time Rushville area resident and business owner, passed away August 9, 2024 at his home in Rushville. Jim was born June 20, 1955 in Johnson County, IN. to James R., Sr. & Margaret Joan (Averitt) Ephlin. He spent his early life in Johnson County and the family moved to Rush County in 1960. Jim was a 1973 graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School and he obtained his BS in Political Science from Ball State University. He married Karen Showalter on February 22, 1992 and she survives.

Jim & Karen owned & operated the Rushville Bowl from 1984-2024. He was instrumental in all things bowling! Jim was affectionately known as “Mr. Bowling” by his bowling community. The USBC had just recognized Jim for bowling in 50 consecutive National opens. He had multiple 300 games and 800 series, bowled on the Ball State University bowling team, was instrumental in starting youth bowling, he began and named the Mid-Indiana Bowling conference which began a bowling team at Rushville High School. Jim was named the bowling proprietor of the year thru the BPAA. Jim was also a member of the First Baptist Church in Rushville.

He will be missed by his wife, Karen, of Rushville, a son, J.T. Ephlin of Rushville, a daughter, Annie Ephlin (Doug Tompkins) of Spiceland, a sister, Cathy (Stephen) Schneider of Rushville and his grandchildren, Aaliyah Jo Ephlin, Hallie Harlow, Isabell, Ryliegh, Myah and Noah Tompkins. Jim was also survived by several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by

his parents.

A Celebration of Jim's life will be held at 5 PM Wednesday, August 14, 2024 in Moster Mortuary, Rushville with Pastor Cody Hensley presiding. Friends are welcome to visit the family on Wednesday in the mortuary from 1:30 until time of service. Burial will follow in the Rushville East Hill Cemetery.
