Janet Y. Malson, 78, a former Rushville resident, passed away Friday, December 19, 2014 in Indianapolis. Janet was born on May 21, 1936 in Milwaukee, WI, to the late Merlin E. and Mildred Mae (Bone) Bechtold. She was a 1954 graduate of Broad Ripple High School.
