Joe Fey, 73, a life long Rush County resident, passed away Friday, October 12, 2012 in Greenfield. He was born on January 12, 1939 in Rush County to Wayne & Lena (Speer) Fey. Joe was a 1957 graduate of New Salem High School.

Joe served in the US Army. He married Darlene J. Miller on March 29, 1959. She preceded him in death on September 22, 2008.
