John William Meek, 72 of Milroy, passed away on July 17, 2019 in Indianapolis. He was born on May 26, 1947 in Greensburg, IN to the late John E. and Thelma (Wilhite) Meek. John was a 1965 graduate of Milroy High School and then received his Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education from Purdue University; where he was a member of the Farmhouse Fraternity.
