John Jared Miller, 69, of Batesville, passed away at his home in Batesville on March 24, 2013. He was born September 8, 1943 in Indianapolis to John Clark & Joanne (Coffin) Miller. He was a 1961 graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School and attended IU. Jared joined the US Navy and served from 1961-1967. He was aboard the USS Kitty Hawk and served during the Vietnam War.
