Joseph C. Fulton, 87, of Rushville IN and formerly of Cambridge, died Monday (April 23, 2018) at the Hancock Regional Hospital in Greenfield IN.

He was born June 21, 1930 in Cambridge, son of the late Clyde M. Fulton and Mabel (Ott) Fulton.

Mr. Fulton retired from Textron as an accountant. He worked for thirty years at the Cambridge plant until its closure and then for ten years at the Morristown IN plant. He had also worked for a few years at Superior Model Company and the Modern Decorating Company.
