Joyce Ann Vogel, 78, a life long Rushville area resident, passed away March 2, 2017 in Greenfield. She was born October 25, 1938 in Rushville to Paul J. & Dorothy (Matlack) Grinstead. Joyce was a 1956 graduate of Rushville High School. She married Richard Vogel on June 21, 1959 and he preceded her in death on October 14, 2014.

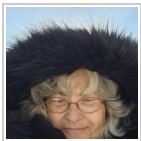
