Kenneth Richard Grizzell, 69, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away Friday, October 2, 2015 in Rushville. Richard was born in Rushville on December 24, 1945 to the late Kenneth and Lucille (Bostic) Grizzell. He was a 1965 graduate of Carthage High School and attended Ivy Tech in 1975. Richard served in the US Marine Corp in Vietnam. He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Knightstown and the American Legion also in Knightstown. Richard retired after 35 years at the Waste water Treatment plant in Knightstown.

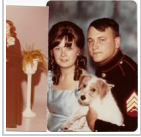
