Leroy Martin, 92, a lifelong resident of Rush County passed away Monday, February 3, 2014 in Rushville. Leroy was born in Rush County on July 16, 1921 to the late Albert and Cora (Childers) Martin. He was a 1939 graduate of Milroy High School.

Leroy served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. He married Joan Carmichael on December 2, 1952 and she preceded him in death on July 12, 1997.
