Leslie "Wayne" Craven, 84, a life long Rush County resident, passed away December 29, 2020 in Richmond. He was born June 30, 1936 in Rush County to Leslie Craven & Fay (Stout) Wolters. He was a PFC in the US Army serving his country from 1954-1956. He was in Company A 54th Engineer Battalion.

Wayne married Shirley Wolfe on May 12, 1957 and she survives.

He worked for Kroger for 47 years before retiring in 1998. Wayne was a member of the American Legion Post #150, the Knights of Columbus and Trinity Presbyterian Church.

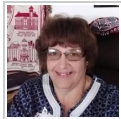

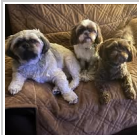
