



Loren Franklin Cull

September 7, 1931 - February 10, 2024

Loren F. Cull, 92, of Rushville, IN, passed away on Saturday, February 10, 2024, at Flat Rock River Lodge. He was born on September 7, 1931, in Rushville, IN, to Clara May (Nighbert) Cull and Noland F. Cull.

Loren was a 1949 graduate of Rushville High School. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict, working as an instructor in the engineering school at Fort Belvoir, VA, and attained the rank of Sergeant. While stationed in Virginia, Loren met and later married Sally Ann Miller on January 3, 1955, in the First Baptist Church of Riverdale, MD. Sally preceded him in death on October 8, 2022.

After they returned to Indiana, Loren and Sally eventually settled on a small farm in southern Rush County where they enjoyed grain farming and raising beef cattle. In addition to farmwork, Loren was also employed for 40 years by the Rush County National Bank which eventually became Wells Fargo Bank.

Loren was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Rushville, serving as a church deacon and on various committees for many years. From 1976 to 1980, Loren was a member of the Board of Education of Rushville Consolidated Schools. Along with his community involvement, Loren had a lifelong passion for motorcycles, and enjoyed riding his Honda Gold Wing,

even past his 80th birthday! He also loved family gatherings where he often prepared his famous deep fried Cajun turkey.

He is survived by daughters Pamela (Kevin) Hoeing of Rushville, IN, Louise (Robert) Judge of Decatur, IN, and son, Stephen (Melissa) Cull of Rushville, IN.
