Lowell Amos Angle, 92, of New Salem, IN passed away on January 19, 2018 in Greensburg, IN. Lowell was born on July 20, 1925 in Richland Township, Rush County, to the late Leroy and Mary (Carroll) Angle. He was married to Louise (Coy) Angle on December 10, 1944 in Clarksburg, IN.
