Lowell G. Monroe, 87, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away Saturday, March 16, 2013 in Rushville, IN. He was born on September 29, 1925 in Rushville to the late Charles Edgar and Addie (Kephard) Monroe. Lowell was a 1944 graduate of Milroy High School. He married Huguette Kuchenbuch on May 10, 1947 and she survives.

Lowell retired from Visteon Ford in Connersville where he worked in assembly. He was a member of Main Street Christian Church for 60 years. Lowell served in the U.S. Army during WW II from 1944 to 1946 and was awarded the Purple Heart. He was a lifetime member of the Rushville American Legion # 150 and a lifetime member of the Disabled American Veterans.

In addition to his wife Huguette of Rushville, Lowell leaves behind 2 sons, Gene and wife Judy Monroe of Rushville and David Monroe of Rushville, IN, daughter Patricia and husband Kenny Thurston of Indianapolis, 12 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren.

Lowell was preceded in death by his parents, 1 brother 1 sister and 1 grandson.

Services will be held at 11 AM Wednesday, March 20, at Moster Mortuary, Rushville. Friends are welcome to visit from 4 to 8 PM Tuesday, March 19 at the mortuary. Rev. Sam Davenport and Pas. Michael Smith will preside. Rush County Honor Guard will conduct Services. Burial will be in Rushville East Hill Cemetery.
