



## Lowell "Toad" Redden

August 5, 1925 - March 25, 2015

Lowell "Toad" Redden, 89, a life long Rush County resident, passed away March 25, 2015 in Rushville. He was born August 5, 1925 in Rushville to Arnol & Flossie (Kennedy) Redden. Lowell married Jewell Porter on June 8, 1946 and she preceded him in death on November 21, 2012. He was a WW2 US Navy veteran.

Lowell retired as service manager in 1989 from Curtis Brothers where he had worked for 43 years. He was a member of the Rushville American Legion Post #150, the VFW, Past Master of the Phoenix Lodge #62 F&AM in Rushville and he was a 33 degree Mason.
