Luella Newkirk, 89, a long time Glenwood area resident, passed away January 11, 2017 at her home. She was born June 11, 1927 in Pike County to Thomas B. & Mima (Selby) Stephenson. She was a 1944 graduate of Petersburg High School, attended Indiana University in Bloomington and graduated from Lockyears's Business College in Evansville.

Luella married John E. Newkirk on August 12, 1947. In 1949, they moved to the Glenwood community where she was a member of the Ben Davis Creek Christian Church, the O.O.S. Club and the Falmouth Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star.

Luella worked 32 years for the Rush County National Bank in Glenwood, retiring in 1987.

She is survived by her son, Thomas W. Newkirk of Glenwood, a brother, Albert Stephenson of Evansville, 4 nephews & 3 nieces. She was preceded in death by her husband John on September 23, 2005.

Services will be held at 1 PM Monday, January 16, 2017 at Moster Mortuary, Rushville, where friends are welcome to visit from 11:30 AM until time of service that day. Burial will be in the Orange Cemetery.
