January 4, 1924 - July 18, 2012

Malia "Jane" Morris, 88, a lifelong Rush County, New Salem area resident passed away Wednesday, July 18, 2012 in Rushville.

Jane was born on January 4, 1924 in Rush County to the late John and Laura (McElfresh) Mastin. She was a 1942 graduate of New Salem High School.

Jane married William "Herbie" Morris on February 1, 1947 and he preceded her in death on August 22, 1989.

Jane worked in the dietary dept. at Rush Memorial Hospital for 25 years and later worked as an assistant teacher at Mary Lee Ball Nursery from 1989 to 1992. She was a lifelong member of Main Street Christian Church and was the first director of the Rush County Girl Scouts.

Jane leaves behind 2 daughters, Mrs. Paul (Sherri) Eckart and Mrs. Michael (Cindy) Alexander both of Rushville, IN, a sister, Eva Meyer of Rush County, 6 grandchildren, Mrs. Jim (Susan) Street, Greg Eckart and wife Miranda, Joe, Tyler and Thomas Alexander, Tiffany Alexander and fiancé John-Charles Peak and 1 great grand daughter Sarah Jane Street.
