Mark Glenn, 69 of Dugger passed away on June 7, 2024 at his home with his loving wife. He was born on August 9, 1954 in Rush County, IN to the late Charles Glenn and Mary (McCarty) Glenn Robertson. 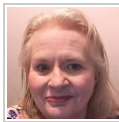
