Mark A. Heimsoth, 45, a lifelong Glenwood area resident, passed away September 8, 2023. Mark was born in Fayette County, Indiana, on March 13, 1978, to Mike & Linda (Schumacher) Heimsoth. He was homeschooled through high school and then studied automotive technology at Universal Technical Institute in Chicago, where he graduated as valedictorian.
