Max W. Tague, 95, a longtime Rushville resident, passed away February 23, 2013 in Avon, IN. He was born December 17, 1917 in Laurel to Gilbert C., Sr. & Margaret Mary "Mayme" (Raham) Tague. Max was a Sergeant with the US Army, serving from 1942-1945. He was with the 44th Fighter Squadron 18th Fighter Group, serving during WW2.

Max married Jean Lemen on October 2, 1971 and she preceded him in death on July 6, 1973. He spent many years with his longtime companion, Ruth Underwood. He was retired from Standard Oil after 44 years as a bulk truck delivery driver. Max was a member of the Laurel Christian Church, the Rushville American Legion Post #150 and the Morristown F&AM #193.
