Melvin R. "Mel" Barton, 53, a lifelong Rushville resident passed away April 30, 2013 at Jewish Hospital in Louisville, KY. Mel was born in Rushville on November 3, 1959 to the late F. Randall and Martha Bell (Porter) Barton. He was a 1978 graduate of Rushville High School and later received a Bachelors Degree and later an MBA in business from Indiana Wesleyan University. 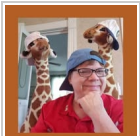
