Milford R. Edwards, 72, a lifelong Rushville resident, passed away at 3:25 AM Saturday, August 11 in St. Francis Hospital, Indianapolis. He was born December 19, 1939 in Rushville to Russell Austin & Ellen (Warfield) Edwards, both deceased.

Milford served in the US Navy from 1960-1964, serving aboard the Aircraft carrier USS Lake Champlain. He married Lorraine Moore on November 1, 1964 and she survives. He retired from Roots-Blower in Connorsville after 37 years. He was an inspector and welder for Roots-Blower and retired in 2000. He was a longtime member of the Rushville Church of Christ where he served as deacon. Milford was an avid fisherman & video gamer. He was a tremendous UK fan!
