Norman L. Winkler, 86, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away, Friday, December 29, 2023 in Morristown. Norman was born in Rush County on April 8, 1937 to the late Cyrus A. and Edith (Shearer) Winkler.

Norman was a 1955 graduate of Arlington High School. He married Priscilla Offutt on December 4, 1960 and she survives. Norman was in the Army Reserves from 1959-1965. Norman was a Rush County farmer his entire life. He was a 4-H leader for 30 years, a past President of the Rush County Council, an elder at Arlington Christian Church and a member of Mt. Pisgah Baptist Church. Norman was on the board of directors for MainSource Bank, formerly Arlington State Bank and Peoples Trust Company.
