Paris O. Cross Jr., 79 of Mays passed away Wednesday, February 23, 2022. Paris was born in Indianapolis on July 23, 1942 to the late Paris O. and Betty Mae (Felt) Cross Sr. He was a 1961 graduate of Mays High School.

Paris married Connie Wooldridge on April 12, 1963 and she survives. Paris operated the family business POC Industry Machine in Mays from 1968 until he retired in 2018. He owned and operated Horseshoe Bend Golf Course.

Paris was a former member of Center Christian Church. Paris was an avid sports car racing driver and enjoyed golf, hunting and being outdoors.
