When she got all excited about something and started ranting about it he would be very quiet and say, "Calm Down Peggy" and she would immediately calm down.

Peggy and Donald went to get married; they were told that they would lose a lot of their disability money if they get married. So they decided to live together. They loved each other very much. One of Donald's cousins, Dale

Ann Kuhn was very dear to both of them. Clairetta is very thankful for Dale Ann. Thank you to everybody that has loved and cared for Peggy during her life. She received a lot of help and care from many people at Margaret Mary Manor Health Clinic.

Peggy had been put out of her home on April 22, 2024. Due to her bipolarism she couldn't handle the stress. She had a cardiac arrest that took her life April 5, 2024. Clairetta is sure Peggy is resting in heaven now without Bipolar and is with her Daddy, Lonnie Lee Bolyard who gave his life to God and answered God's call to Mission work also as soon as he became a Christian.
